Tetrahedron Privacy Policy

Effective date: June 22, 2026

This Privacy Policy is a first draft for review by counsel. Do not publish until approved.

1. Scope

This Privacy Policy explains how Take Flight Data Management collects, uses, stores, shares, and protects information when you use Tetrahedron, our website, applications, trading tools, notifications, and support services.

2. Information We Collect

We may collect:

- Account information: name, email, login details, subscription status, and account settings.
- Exchange connection information: exchange name, account connection status, API-key metadata, permissions, encrypted credentials, and connection diagnostics.
- Trading information: proposals, orders, execution logs, paper trades, live trade metadata, positions, PnL summaries, risk settings, automation settings, fees, alerts, and audit logs.
- Usage information: pages viewed, features used, clicks, settings changes, timestamps, device/browser data, IP address, logs, errors, and diagnostic telemetry.
- Payment information: subscription plan, billing status, invoices, payment processor IDs, refund status, and tax-related metadata. Payment card details should be handled by the payment processor, not stored by us.
- Communications: support messages, email alerts, SMS alert settings, notification preferences, and correspondence.
- AI/reporting information: prompts, summaries, recap reports, model outputs, and analytics derived from your trading/account data.

3. How We Use Information

We use information to:

- Provide, secure, operate, and improve the service.
- Authenticate users and protect accounts.
- Connect to exchanges at your direction.
- Generate proposals, automation decisions, reports, alerts, and account views.
- Process subscriptions and billing.
- Troubleshoot errors, investigate incidents, and provide support.
- Maintain audit logs and security records.
- Comply with legal obligations and enforce policies.

4. Exchange Credentials

Trade-enabled API credentials are sensitive. We intend to store exchange credentials encrypted at rest and tenant-scoped. You are responsible for configuring exchange permissions, safeguarding your exchange account, and revoking API keys directly at the exchange if needed.

We should not request withdrawal permissions unless counsel and security review approve a specific feature that requires them.

5. Sharing Information

We may share information with:

- Infrastructure and hosting providers.
- Payment processors.
- Notification providers such as email or SMS vendors.
- Analytics, logging, and security tools.
- Professional advisers, including counsel and accountants.
- Law enforcement, regulators, courts, or other parties when legally required or necessary to protect rights and safety.
- Exchanges or API providers when needed to operate a user-directed integration.

We do not sell trading strategy data as a standalone data product unless a future policy expressly says so and users are given legally required rights.

6. Data Retention

We retain information as long as reasonably needed to provide the service, maintain audit trails, troubleshoot issues, comply with law, resolve disputes, enforce agreements, and support security. Retention periods may differ by data type.

7. Security

We use administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards intended to protect information. No system is perfectly secure. Users remain responsible for device security, exchange-account security, API-key permissions, and credential revocation.

8. Privacy Rights

Depending on your location, you may have rights to access, correct, delete, export, restrict, or object to certain processing of your personal information. You may contact **[Privacy Email]** to make a request.

California, Colorado, Virginia, Connecticut, Utah, GDPR, and other regional language requires counsel review before public launch.

9. Cookies And Tracking

We may use cookies, local storage, analytics, and similar technologies for authentication, security, preferences, performance, and product analytics. More detail appears in the Cookie and Tracking Notice.

10. Children

The service is not intended for children under 13 and is not intended for users under 18. We do not knowingly collect information from children under 13.

11. International Use

The service may not be available in all countries or states. If you use the service outside the United States, you are responsible for confirming that your use is lawful.
